Coco+ = giving young individuals an opportunity to make thoughtful decisions about their working careers

....in terms of goals (aims)

- strengthen the cooperation between schools and regional economy and business
- preventing early school leaving, "dropout".
- entrepreneurial way of learning be creative and innovative.
- evaluate the quality of arrangements and propose modifications
- share the experience of the testing across sectors within countries, transnationally, and within sectors across Europe

....in terms of resources (time, partners)

- project duration: 01.09.2017.-31.08.2020.
- project partners: Norway, Germany, Croatia, Hungary, Czech Republic (Pardubice, Česke Budejovice), Portugal



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Vocational education programs have made a real difference in the lives of countless young people nationwide; they build self-confidence and leadership skills by allowing students to utilize their unique gifts and talents.


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2. Impact on the Croatian team

Entrepreneurial visits and presentations

- activity of inviting local entrepreneurs to hold short lectures about their work-ventures

Student presentations and impartment of knowledge

• the progress of the project, project activities, has been continuously shown through student presentations held in front of the teachers council (e.g. Blended Mobility, Chemnitz, Germany, 17th-23rd September 2018)





- connecting Erasmus+ projects our students have also used knowledge collected in another Erasmus+ project ('Robots Boots Skills) and have acted as mentors to students during a project activity held in South Bohemia, Czech Republic (May,2019)
- this only shows how applicable Erasmus+ project knowledge is in various domains

Career Day (7th November, 2018 / 13th December, 2019)

- a fair of local universities, businesses and entrepreneurs who want to introduce their work
- an unique opportunity for young individuals to collect information from multiple sources in order to explore further their options
- the ability of asking questions and finding out how a certain institution (business) functions and whether there is a future educational and/or job possibilities
